



Tecnológico de Monterrey ranks 187th in the QS World University Rankings 2026

- The institution remains among the world's top 200 universities and is ranked 29th among private universities globally.
- Tec's highest-ranking indicators in this edition are: employment outcomes, employer reputation, and academic reputation.
- This global ranking supports Tec de Monterrey's "Rumbo al 2030" goals, which focus on attracting exceptional talent and continuing to strengthen academic excellence through innovation and applied research.

Monterrey, Nuevo León, June 19, 2025.- Tecnológico de Monterrey reaffirmed its position among the world's Top 200 universities, reaching 187th place in the QS World University Rankings 2026. According to the ranking, it is the number one private university in Mexico and 29th globally.

This result brings the institution closer to fulfilling the objectives of its "*Rumbo al 2030*" vision, which seeks to attract top talent through an educational approach based on innovation and applied research to transform reality.

According to **David Garza Salazar**, Executive President of the Tecnológico de Monterrey Educational Group: "Our recognition goes to our professors, researchers, students, and collaborators, whose effort and dedication are key to strengthening academic excellence, research, and our institution's impact, which allows us to reaffirm our position among the top 200 universities in the world."

"As part of our Rumbo al 2030 vision, we aim to enhance Tec's global reputation to attract top talent. We've made research one of our strategic priorities because we consider it essential for an excellent academic institution. We're motivated by the possibility of Tec generating greater impact on society through it," he added.

For this edition, the international ranking body evaluated a total of 8,476 higher education institutions across 106 countries, of which only 1,501 were ranked. In Mexico, 22 universities were included in the list.

According to **Juan Pablo Murra Lascurain**, Rector of Tecnológico de Monterrey, the institution remains committed to providing excellent education, applied research, and social impact projects that transform lives and communities.

Being among the top 200 universities worldwide is possible thanks to the talent and leadership of our faculty, researchers, students, and academic and administrative teams, who drive solutions that transform reality and reaffirm the institution's mission of preparing leaders capable of addressing the major challenges of our time," he said.

The highest-performing indicators for Tecnológico de Monterrey were: Employment Outcomes (52nd), Employer Reputation (55th globally), and Academic Reputation (136th).





Feniosky Peña-Mora, Executive Vice President of Research and Dean of Engineering and Sciences, commented: "Tec's presence in the Top 200 of the QS World University Rankings 2026 reflects the steady progress of our institutional strategy in science, technology, and innovation. With more than 1,100 researchers across six Schools, three Institutes, and six Research Centers, we generate knowledge that informs public policy, drives industrial development, and promotes social well-being. This recognition consolidates Tec's role as a key player in the global research ecosystem with impact from Latin America."

The QS World University Rankings, prepared by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS), is based on nine evaluation criteria: Academic Reputation (30%), Research Citations per Faculty (20%), Employer Reputation (15%), Faculty/Student Ratio (10%), International Student Ratio (5%), International Faculty Ratio (5%), Employment Outcomes (5%), International Research Network (5%), and Sustainability (5%).

QS has published this ranking since 2004 to evaluate and compare the performance of universities worldwide.
